Rules for Granting Scholarships for Publications from Specific Research Grant Projects at NCBR in 2019

Scholarships may be paid for all publications where a student of MSP or DSP Biochemistry, field **Biomolecular Chemistry**, field **Genomics and Proteomics** or MSP Biochemistry, field **Chemoinformatics and Bioinformatics** or DSP Life Sciences, field **Structural Biology** or field **Bioomics** is an **author or co-author** and that are published during the period from **1 January 2019 to 30 September 2019** or that were published in 2018 after the deadline for submitting applications for scholarships that year, and that have not yet been awarded with any scholarship. The publications must also include **student's affiliation to NCBR** and must be duly **registered in the IS MU** no later than by 30 September 2019. Also publications that were not published before 30 September 2019, but are accepted for publication, can be awarded. Scholarships for publications will be paid out in the course of November 2019 and their amount will be derived from the total number of all publications, authorship order (main author, co-author) and journal quality.

The scholarship may be paid only to students who are **at most in 5th year of their DSP study** in the day of acceptance of article for publishing. Students in higher years of DSP study are not eligible for this scholarship.

According to the Scholarship Rules a scholarship can be paid only when the beneficiary is registered as a student at MU, i.e. no later than on the day of completion of studies. Therefore, if a student intends to finish his/her study program in 2019, and he/she is eligible to obtain this scholarship, it is necessary to apply for earlier payment of the scholarship - not later than three weeks before the scheduled date of the defence.

The scholarship for publications is granted based on application sent to the following email: martinp@chemi.muni.cz .

Specification of NCBR affiliation

Affiliation is a name and address of institution specified with author's name in the list of publication authors. NCBR affiliation should be specified as follows:

National Centre for Biomolecular Research, Faculty of Science, Masaryk University, Kamenice 5, 625 00 Brno, Czech Republic

The affiliation can be appropriately modified to correspond to the format of specific journal affiliations, e.g. it is possible to avoid street name and/or postal code.

If a student specifies another affiliation belonging to MU (e.g. CEITEC, Fac. Sci., etc.), together with NCBR affiliation, it does not affect the scholarship. Nevertheless, if a student specifies affiliation of institution which does not belong to MU (together with NCBR affiliation), the scholarship is reduced (to 1/2 if one non-MU affiliation is specified, to 1/3 in case of two, etc.).

Scholarship for creation of successful cover art

Scholarship in the total amount CZK 5,000 may be paid to an individual or team for creating successful cover art graphics, if a student is enrolled in any of the above mentioned study fields and the NCBR affiliation is specified.
